English for Academic Preparation program

The English for Academic Preparation (EAP) Program is an intensive language program that emphasizes university preparation and academic skills needed for successful university study (undergraduate and graduate) in the United States.

Program

- **Dates:** September 4 – December 18, 2019
 - Arrive by Sept. 3, depart Dec. 19th or later
- **Duration:** 12 weeks (fall break included) + 3 weeks customized
- **Hours:**
 - 12 weeks: 22 hours of language instruction per week, Monday – Thursday. No required classes on Fridays, but optional classes, activities and volunteering
 - 2 weeks in December: small mixed level section completing an advanced project and site visits to utilize language skills gained in the previous 12 weeks. Curriculum will be adjusted based on level of students.

- **Requirements to participate:** 18 years or older. Able to speak, read and understand simple English, and write simple English sentences. Students will take an institutional TOEFL test upon arrival and be placed into levels ranging from low intermediate to advanced.
- **Location:** SF State Main Campus

Application Process

- **How to apply:**
 - Online application or Paper application
 - Deadline to apply – Monday, July 15th
 - Required supplemental documents (for I-20 issuance):
 - Copy of passport biographical page
 - Financial Affidavit and Health Insurance Agreement
 - Financial letter/statement demonstrating enough funds to pay for all academic and living expenses for 4 months of study
 - show at least **\$13280 USD or equivalent in other currency**
 - be written in English and clearly detail the account owner and available funds
 - be on bank/financial institution letterhead
 - dated within the past 6 months
 - Visa: students must come on an F-1 student visa. An I-20 form is issued to students to apply for the F-1 visa. Student visa overview, application process, fees, and more information is available in the U.S. Department of State website
